The next international trip will be to Croatia sometime during the first three weeks of May '09 since the charter rates take a jump after that. The format will be the same as the Italy trip last year, one week of sailing and a week or so on land depending on who wants to do what.

I'm currently starting to plan the land portion for Melita and me. Don't know yet, but will probably spend some time sightseeing both before and after the sailing like we did last year. If anyone wants join us for portions of the land trip, I'll be happy to make the reservations with ours. People wanting a different itinerary will be responsible for their own reservations with the exception of hotel reservations the night before and the night after the sailing portion of the trip.

I'm currently looking at The Moorings and Sunsail since they offer a one way trip option (from Split-Kremik to Dubrovnik) like we had in France. There is an additional charge for this, however it allows us to see more of the area without having to backtrack.

Since this trip is only a year away, the initial deposit will be \$500 and be due by the June 6th meeting or can also be given to me at the May meeting on Tuesday. Checks are to be made out to "Croatia '09". The "you're in or out" cutoff date has yet to be determined, but probably won't be before September.

Here's a ballpark figure of what the trip would cost...fine tuning will come as planning continues.
