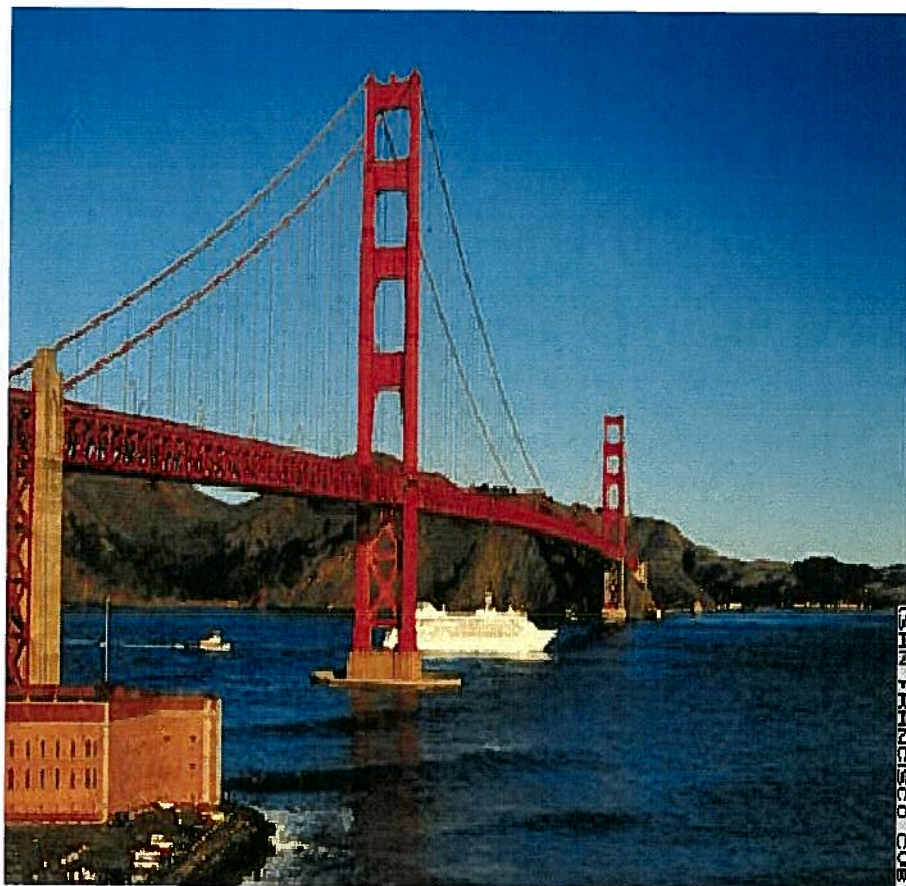

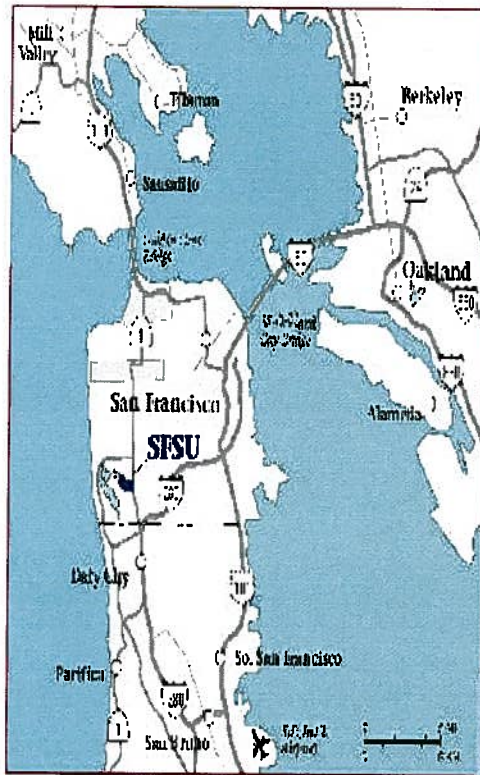
SAC has reserved one boat (Benateau 393 – “Oxygen”) through Modern Sailing in Sausalito for October 10-12 (Friday thru Sunday) with pre-board on Thursday evening. Estimate total cost is \$375 per person for the three days sailing (and four nights on the boat). Price includes a rental vehicle for the weekend to get folks from Oakland airport to the marina in Sausalito, etc. A deposit of \$100 is required by the August SAC meeting and balance will be due by the September meeting. We can potentially get a second boat if we have enough signups / commitments and a skipper.

We plan to fly to Oakland on Thursday afternoon, pick up a van there and drive over to Sausalito. We will be in the Bay area for 3-4 day, sailing each day and then touring/dining-out in the evening which will give us plenty of opportunity to see several areas of the Bay. Sausalito has some great restaurants or we can go into SF for an evening out. If folks want to tour the ships, we recommend that they do that on Monday the 13th – less crowded than on the weekend.

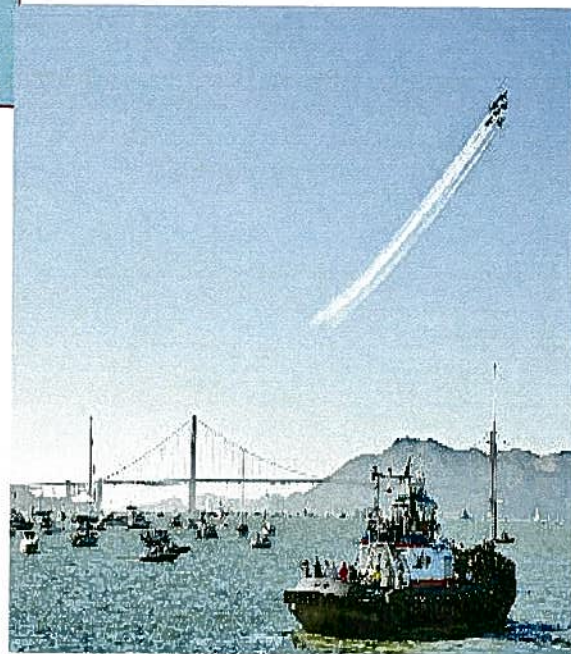
